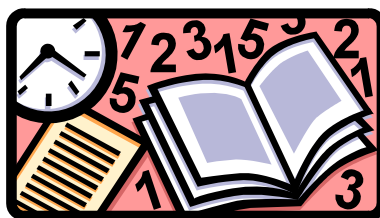


Sensei says you should read. In fact you should spend a great deal of time this summer reading.
